November financials reflect the activities of our church's giving, expenditures, and reimbursements for the month.

General giving totaled \$13,455.95 for the month with an additional \$8,550.89 received in special funds. This brings our regular giving to 71.57% of our goal for the year. Total disbursements were \$12,319.36 for the month, bringing our total expenditures to 71% of budgeted annual expenses for eleven months through the year.


