





February financials reflect the activities of our church's giving, expenditures, and reimbursements for the month.

General giving totaled \$ 14,668.61 for the month with an additional \$3,675.00 received in This brings our regular giving to 15.5% of our goal for the year. Total special funds. disbursements were \$ 18,759.90 for the month, bringing our total expenditures to 21% of budgeted annual expenses for the current year.

The transition of Director of Finance responsibilities from R.D. Williams to Brenda Whidden continues very smoothly. Brenda has assumed the regular duties for reconciling the bank statements and creating the financial statements each month with minimal input from R.D. Brenda's willingness to take on this responsibility is greatly appreciated.

The church made a significant payment of \$9,750.00 towards the replacement of the main electrical panel serving the Sanctuary portion of our building. There have been several generous donations to help offset a portion of this expense, if you are able to contribute any additional amount towards this necessary improvement. please indicate on vour check VANCO or submission your gift is for the special electrical repair project.

The checking account has been reconciled for the month.
